**Significant increase in the highest A-Level Grades**

At South Wolds our aim is to enable youngsters to meet their academic and social potential. In 2013 our great students have once again smashed our ambitious A-Level targets. They are a fantastically talented group of youngsters who deserve their success and have great futures in front of them.

We are delighted that the number of students achieving the very highest grades increased significantly. In 2013 the percentage of students achieving A\*-B Grades was 53% which is a 6% increase from 2012.

In the coming days Mr Jenkins and the Sixth Form Leadership Team will be working with students to finalise their university placements or other plans for the future.

In 2011 we put in place a series of measures to ensure that the performance of our Sixth Form matched the needs and aspirations of our community. The outstanding results in 2012 have now been matched by these results in 2013, confirming that our Sixth Form is a great platform for ambitious youngsters who want to reach or exceed their potential in A-Level qualifications.

No wonder we have received the highest ever number of applications for places in Year 12 in September 2013.

In summary the results are:

A\*-A Grades – 23%

A\*-B Grades – 53%

A\*-C grades – 75%

98% Pass Rate

76% of students achieved A\*-B grades in Biology, 67% in Business, 69% in Chemistry, 77% in English Literature, 71% in Maths and 57% in Physics.

Congratulations to all the students and staff who worked so hard to achieve these great results.
