2016 GCSE Results

**Bucking the national trend with highest ever number of students
achieving the best grades in English and maths!**

Congratulations to the class of 2016! Another fantastic set of results here at South Wolds: well done to all of our students, we are incredibly proud of you. Yet again the media have reported that 'national GCSE results have fallen...including a sharp decline in the numbers gaining a C grade or above in English.' Not so for us here at South Wolds!

There are significant increases in many of our results, have a look at our headline figures:

Overall

- ✓ **83% A*-C in English and maths** (8% increase from 2015)
- ✓ 77% 5xA*-C including English and maths
- ✓ 30% English Baccalaureate
- ✓ 27% 5xA*-A (3% increase from 2015)
- ✓ 16% 8xA*-A (2% increase from 2015)

English

- ✓ 84% A*-C
- ✓ 20% A*-A
- ✓ 84% expected progress from Key Stage 2 (6% increase from 2015)
- ✓ 45% more than expected progress from Key Stage 2 (13% increase from 2015)

Maths

- ✓ 89% A*-C
- ✓ 34% A*-A (5% increase from 2015)
- ✓ 83% expected progress from Key Stage 2
- ✓ 55% more than expected progress from Key Stage 2 (15% increase from 2015)

Disadvantaged students

- ✓ 69% A*-C in English and maths (25% increase from 2015)
- ✓ 58% 5xA*-C including English and maths
- ✓ 63% expected progress in maths
- ✓ 50% expected progress in English
- ✓ 29% more than expected progress in English
- ✓ 33% more than expected progress in maths (28% increase from 2015)
