Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the briefing led by the Prime Minister yesterday afternoon, updated guidance had been released regarding measures that all schools are being asked to implement, in relation to helping stop the spread of COVID—19. The most significant update is regarding face coverings. Please can you ensure your child brings a face covering to school from tomorrow morning. If they travel to school on dedicated school transport or a public bus they must wear a face covering, unless they are exempt.

All students will be required to wear face coverings in communal areas on the school site, unless they are exempt. We will continue to provide face coverings if any student needs one and has forgotten theirs. This includes in corridors, during break times, lunch times and assemblies.

We will continue to monitor the situation in line with any further guidance issued by the government. Please can you continue to support the situation by taking part in twice weekly asymptomatic testing using the lateral flow tests supplied. If your child displays any symptoms please do not send them in to school and book a PCR test for them as soon as you are able.
