Dear Parents and Carers,

We are really excited to welcome back all of our students to the new Autumn term and as we prepare for their return I felt it would be helpful to clarify a number of issues for your reference. There has been a great deal of focus on possible school closures due to the conditions of some school building across England which has led to some confusion regarding schools being ready for the Autumn term. May I reassure you that at South Wolds we have not been informed by the DfE that the school is affected by the reinforced autoclaved aerated concrete (RAAC) issue and are ready to welcome Year 7 and 12 students on site on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September and the rest of the school on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September.

The weather has decided to smile down upon us this week but with temperatures due to become rather high, we are mindful of student comfort during these hotter periods. Therefore, students have the choice to wear the summer uniform which means no tie or blazer are required; smart tailored shorts can be worn along with the usual school skirt or trousers. This will be in effect up until the end of this week and then the regular uniform requirements will be in place from Monday 11th September.
