Form Tutor

The tutor has a pivotal role to play and will act as the first point of contact between school and home. Due to their daily contact with students, tutors build meaningful relationships with the students in their group. Where concerns of a social or academic nature arise, tutors will initiate contact with parents/carers to resolve issues, normally via email, letter or phone call. Behaviour for Learning Mentor

She is responsible for working with students, parents/carers and staff regarding mental health, anti -bullying, equality, diversity and the safe use of social media.

Heads of Year

Heads of Year oversee all aspects of the students' school experience to ensure it is positive and harmonious. They are responsible for tracking the attitudes to learning of all students and will work closely with tutors and the Senior Perfomance Leader to ensure support is available where it is needed.
